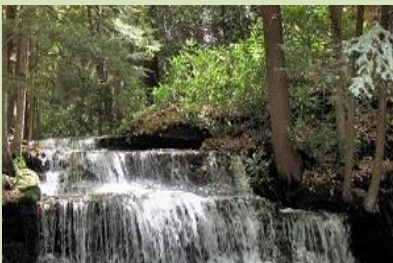


DCNR Bureau of Forestry Public Input Meeting for Tiadaghton State Forest Resource Management Plan (Tiadaghton SFRMP)

Purpose of the Meeting

Citizens will have an opportunity to present input regarding the draft version of the new Tiadaghton SFRMP. The SFRMP guides management activities within the district forest. It provides a framework from which managers prioritize objectives and strategies to accomplish goals. The SFRMP accounts for district resources and serves as communication to Pennsylvania citizens regarding how their forest is managed.
